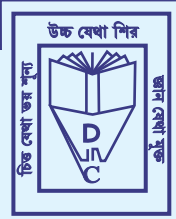
- Selection will be strictly on the basis of merit.
- Merit list for admission is displayed on college website and college notice board on the date stipulated by the University of Calcutta.
- Admission is provisional, subject to scrutiny and verification of the documents submitted. Provisional admission is liable to be cancelled if the candidate fails to submit documents required by the University.



GENERAL RULES AND NORMS

THE COLLEGE OFFERS ADMISSION TO ALL STUDENTS IRRESPECTIVE OF RELIGION, RACE, CASTE & SEX.

1. Only properly filled-in Admission form along with attested copies of Admit Card and Mark Sheet of qualifying Examination will be considered for Admission to Degree course streams.
2. Students seeking admission to this College on transfer must submit the above documents mentioned in item No.1 along with Transfer Certificate from the authority of the institution last studied in.
3. A candidate with a break in study may be admitted as per Calcutta University rules.
4. Admission to the Three-year Degree course in all the streams, both in Honours and in General courses for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and others will be according to W.B. Govt. Rules.
5. Criteria for admission to Honours and General courses will be as per Calcutta University Rules.
6. Every student is required to carry the students' identity card and produce the same whenever required.
7. No student is normally permitted to withdraw studentship in the middle of an academic session. Only in an emergency situation, he/ she may apply for transfer after clearing all annual dues. Such an application must contain the signatures of both the student and his/ her guardian. The decision of the College authority in this respect would be final.
8. A candidate pursuing a regular course of study for three year semester - wise degree course shall have to clear all semestars in all respects within a span of five years from the year of admission to the particular course and combination, failing which enrolment of the candidate shall stand cancelled.



ACADEMIC SESSION

The 3 year B.A/ B.Sc. (Honours and General) Course of studies under CBCS shall consist of six (6) Semester (Semester- I , Semester- II, Semester- III, Semester- IV, Semester- V, and Semester- VI).

Semester Examinations are to be held ordinarily at the end of the concerned Semester, ie Semester-I, Semester- III, Semester- V in **December-January** and Semester- II, Semester- IV, Semester- VI in **June-July**.

The duration of daily class-hours on full weekdays extends from 10.30 A.M. to 5.15 P.M. and on Saturdays from 10.30A.M. to 1.50 P.M.

INTERNAL DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to maintain the internal discipline and sanctity of this institution.

Students are strongly warned against Indulging in any of the following acts:

1. Any activity inimical to students'interest.
2. Wilful destruction of any College property.
3. Postering or writing on walls inside the College building.
4. Loitering on the corridors during class hours.
5. To stand proxy for an absentee during roll-call.
6. To disturb a class in any way during a lecture.
7. Long absence from class-attendance without properly informing and taking permission from College authority.
8. Indulgence in any unfair means during an Examination of the College.
9. Use of mobile phone in a classroom and in examination hall by both student and staff is strictly prohibited.
10. Students must keep their Identity Cards with themselves during college hours.
11. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Violations, if any, will be referred to the Anti-ragging committee of the college.

In case of any of the above-mentioned violations, the College authority will take penal action as per rule.



Outline of Choice Based Credit System (B.A / B.Sc.)

- A) Core Course (CC) :** A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.
- B) Elective Course :** Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline / subject of study.
- I) Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course :** Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline / subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective.
- ii) Generic Elective (GE) Course :** An elective Course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek a wide exposure, is called a Generic Elective.
- N.B. :** A Core course offered in a discipline / subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline / subject and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective. [A core course (CC) of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (General) may be treated as Generic Elective for B.A. / B.Sc./B.Com. (Major)].
- C) Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) :** The Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) may be two kinds : Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC).
- a) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) :** AECC courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement. These are mandatory for all disciplines. I) AECC1 : Communicative English /MIL(Bengali /Hindi /Urdu) ; II) AECC2 : Environmental Studies.
- b) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) :** These Course may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide-value based and /or skill-based knowledge and are aimed at providing competencies, skills, etc.
- **Practical / Tutorial :** Every Core Course, Discipline Specific Elective and Generic Elective Course shall have a Practical /Tutorial component. Wherever there is a practical there will be no Tutorial and vice - versa.

ATTENDANCE

- A Student attending at least 75% of the total number of classes * held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulations.
- A Student attending at least 60% but less than 75% of the total number of classes* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to the payment of prescribed condonation fees and fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulations.
- A Student attending less than 60% of the total number of classes *held shall not be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations and he / she has to pursue admission to the same semester in the very next year for attending the classes and appearing at the said Semester Examinations.

**Such attendance will be calculated from the date of commencement of classes or date of admission, whichever is later.*



EXAMINATION REGULATION

- 1) End Semester Examinations will be held for 80% of the total marks in each paper and Internal Assessment shall be for 20% of the total marks of each paper/ subject/ module. 50% of the total marks assigned to Internal Assessment (i.e.10 marks for a full paper of 100 or 5 marks for a module of 50, as the case may be) will be assessed on the basis of Internal Examination and remaining 50% will be assessed based on the class attendance (6 marks for attending 60% or above but less than 75% of the number of lecture delivered; 8 marks for attending 75% or above but less than 90% of the number of lectures delivered;and 10 marks for attending 90% or above of lecture delivered and such attendance will be calculated from the date of commencement of classes or date of admission whichever is later)

The students will be informed about the modalities of internal assesment well in advance

For examinations in subjects other than language - based ones candidates shall have the option of writing their answers in either Bengali or English unless instructed otherwise in - respective question paper(s).

For examinations in language - based subjects (e.g., Bengali, Hindi, Urdu, English etc.) candidates shall have to write their answers in the respective language only.

5) An Examination shall be held always under the current syllabus.



Master of Commerce

The only Post - graduate department of Netaji Nagar Day College is of the department of Commerce. It was started in the academic session 2006-07 and is affiliated to the University of Calcutta. The M.Com programme is offered in Accounts and Finance. From the academic session 2018 -19, the M.Com is running Under the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS). Dr. Pranjal Chakraborty is the Co.- ordinator of the PG programme in Commerce.

The first Convocation of the M.Com programme was held on 9th September 2013 for five batches successful students. The second convocation saw 143 students being awarded their post - graduate degrees. The results of the PG Department have been Consistently good. Of the 13 students who were enrolled for the Part II examination of M.Com in the year 2018. all 13 appeared for the examination and were successful. Out of these, 5 candidates were awarded first class.
